What is the Lead and Copper Rule?

In 1991, EPA published a regulation to control lead and copper in drinking water. This regulation is known as the Lead and Copper Rule (also referred to as the LCR).

2. What is a Service Line?

Service lines carry water from JEA's public water supply in the underground water mains outside of your property directly to the plumbing fixtures inside of your property. Property owners are responsible for the water service line/plumbing from their property to the meter.
